THE HOLIDAY SURROUNDINGS IN JAMMERBUGT MUNICIPALITY

Every year over 250,000 people accommodate the more than 8,100 holiday homes in Jammerbugt Municipality. This outline directs and gives advice on precautions concerning the nature, the environment, and service to all tourists and property owners.

PLEASE PAY ATTENTION TO THE FOLLOWING:

TAKE CARE OF NATURE

- Keep to the laid out roads and paths in the sand dunes
- When driving on the beach, keep a distance of at least 20 m to the shoreline
- Do not dispose of waste in the nature
- Do not dig in the sand dunes – the storm will enlarge the hole quickly
- Vegetation and preservation arrangements on the dunes may not to be removed

SHOW CONSIDERATION FOR YOUR NEIGHBOUR

- Dogs must always be kept in a lead
- Only play the radio indoor
- Avoid undue noise
- Avoid entering the properties of others
- Keep your property tidy
- Only set up caravans and tents on the property temporarily

WASTE

- Utilise the round waste containers for glass and bottles – this includes plastic bottles and beverage cans
- Make sure to attach the bag correctly to the waste rack
- Only fill up the rubbish bag to the marking
- ADDITIONAL rubbish bags can be purchased at rental agencies and certain stores

BE AWARE OF FIRE HAZARDS

- Do not light bonfires or burn off waste
- Do not throw cigarette stubs and matches on the ground
- Clean the chimney's spark catcher
- When parking the car, make sure the exhaust pipe does not touch vegetation
- Make sure to check where you can retrieve fire-fighting equipment
- Dispose grilling charcoal and cinder into a metal bucket

WATER SAFETY

- BATHING GUIDELINES

- Learn how to swim and how to head dive properly
- Never enter the water alone
- Swim along the shoreline
- Never step into the sea when under the influence of alcohol or psychedelic drugs
- Exit the water if you start to feel cold
- Inflatable water toys, airbeds, and small boats are dangerous to use at sea
- Do not let the children out of sight
- Only shout for help when necessary

DRIVING

- Stay within the speed limits
- Drive slowly on gravel road – this causes less dust
- Drive according to the condition of the road – this helps maintain it

A phone is available by all camping sites. Along the dunes by the coast, there are unstaffed rescue posts with rescue equipment. The beaches are equipped with signs on which you find beach numbers (E-number), indicating your exact location.
